The Liverpool Library offers exhibit, display, and bulletin board space as part of its mission to reach out to the community it serves and to promote education, recreation, cultural enrichment, and lifelong learning, as well as to publicize library resources.

Bulletin Boards

Bulletin board space not in use by the library may be assigned to organizations engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, or charitable activities.

Posting of materials is by permission of the Director or designee and is scheduled on a temporary basis. Posting does not constitute endorsement by the library, staff, or Board of Trustees.

Displays and Exhibits

Art exhibits and other displays are chosen at the discretion of the Director and designee in keeping with the mission of the library.

The Director has the final decision on the arrangement of all exhibits and displays. The Library reserves the right to reject any part of an exhibit or to change the manner it is displayed or identified.

The Library accepts no responsibility for the protection, possible damage, or theft of any item displayed, exhibited, or posted. All items placed on display at the Library are at the owner's risk. Insurance coverage is the responsibility of the owner of the articles or materials displayed.
